Son of God	Jesus the son of God	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Christians believe Jesus is the son of God he was both God and man. • Christians believe Jesus has power and authority from God over every aspect of creation, life and death. • There are people who have stood up and spoken out against authorities in situations of injustice. • The Jewish holy day is Shabbat and there are many traditions and rules associated with Shabbat.
Authority	Power to command or control others.	
Miracle	Wonderful and surprising event, believed to have been caused by God.	
Sabbath	Day of worship and rest in some religions: Saturday for Jews and Sunday for Christians.	
Shabbat	The name of the day of rest in Judaism. Shabbat happens on the seventh day (Saturday) of every week. In Judaism, the day is defined with the cycle of the sun: The day begins and ends at sunset, not midnight.	
Pharisees	Members of an ancient Jewish sect, distinguished by strict observance of the traditional and written law, and commonly held to have pretensions to superior sanctity.
